Notice to Taxpayers of Montgomery County, Ohio
Rates of Taxation for 2005 (Payable 2006)

In Pursuance of Law, I, HUGH QUILL, Treasurer of Montgomery County, Ohio, do hereby give notice that the number of mill levies on each dollar of property listed for taxation within said county on the General Tax List and General Duplicate for the year 2005 is as follows:

TAX LEVIES FOR COUNTY PURPOSES: The total County Levy of 18.24 mills consists of the General fund, 1.70 Mills; Community College 2.50 Mills; Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities, 1.00 Mills; Montgomery County Park District, 1.80 Mills; Human Services Levy 1993(A), 5.21 Mills; Human Services Levy 2003(B), 6.03 Mills.

Taxpayers have several options for payment:

- 1) Pay by mail or in the Treasurer's office with a check, money order, or Discover credit card. When mailing, enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for return of your tax receipt. D-15.
2) Pay on the internet by electronic check, using a regular checking account. Choose "Pay taxes by Check" at www.mctreas.org. No fee is added to this option.
3) Call 225-4010 and choose Option 4 to set up an automatic deduction from your checking or savings account on the due date or to set up a Prepayment (escrow) account with the Treasurer's Office. There is no fee for this service.
4) To pay by Visa, Mastercard or American Express: on the internet: choose "Pay taxes by Credit Card" at www.mctreas.org. OR by telephone: call 1-800-2PAY TAX, enter jurisdiction code 4530 and follow the voice prompts. A convenience fee is added when using credit cards. THESE CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED IN THE TREASURER'S OFFICE OR BY PHONE TO THE TREASURER'S OFFICE.
5) Drop your payment in the white County mailbox at the curb on Third Street in front of the Administration Building main entrance at 451 West Third Street. Please do not use cash for a drop-off payment.
